I was enjoying an afternoon at Stegried & Roy's Secret Garden in Las Vegas. The famous white tigers and white lions are the stars, but I wandered over to the dolphin exhibit first. Standing with excited families, I watched as keepers interacted with several dolphins, including a darling young one.

Heading to the underground viewing area afterward, I stood next to a huge window with two women and a small boy. We quietly strained our eyes through the milky glass, waiting for the dolphins to swim near us. In an instant, that same baby dolphin darted in front of our window. The boy waved his little hands, and immediately the baby dolphin circled back. We laughed as that three-foot-tall minion "stood" upright directly in front of the boy, flippers out in front of him and mouth opened in a smile. The baby then swooped from side to side, spun around, and tipped back on his tail. He had eyes only for that boy and stayed directly in front of him. While we applauded, baby dolphin continued to perform his entire repertoire of tricks, eventually swimming away to join the other – but not before looking back with a sideways grin.

Our group looked at each other in amazement. Are dolphins typically that interested in humans on the other side of the glass? We shared photos, still in awe of that special moment.

As I remembered that young entertainer the rest of the day, I laughed. Stress can be an ugly beast that brings heaviness to the spirit, and I'd had loads of it as I headed into that

conservation area. But seeing that animated dolphin interact with a human on such a personal level had lifted the weight. God gives us laughter to relieve those dark feelings, and that perfectly timed protégé was His gift.

Walk of faith: Look around for the unexpected today. Laugh with a friend. Find an animal to hug. Smile at a stranger. Let joy find its way to your soul.

15. Peace of mind is finding everything just the way you left it the night before.

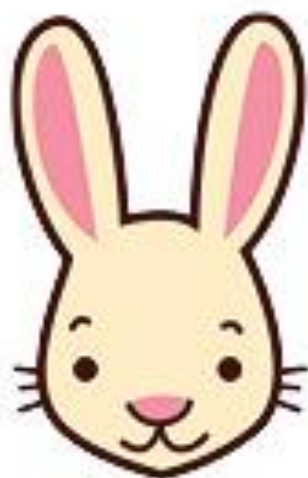
